Shooting Incident

2228 Haverford Road

Update to the shooting incident that occurred on August 13, 2021 in the parking lot of Wynnewood Lanes Bowling and Lounge, 2228 Haverford Road, Ardmore, PA.

On Tuesday, August 24, 2021, Jamil Devon Wynder, B/M/28, was taken in to custody by the U.S. Marshals in Philadelphia, PA and turned over to the Haverford Township Police Department. He was arraigned and his bail was set at \$750,000 cash. He was transported to Delaware County Prison. He was charged with the following violations:

Criminal Homicide (Attempt)
Aggravated Assault
Recklessly Endangering Another Person
Robbery
Terroristic Threats
Simple Assault

On Friday, August 13, 2021, at 2220 hours, the Haverford Township Police Department responded to Wynnewood Lanes Bowling and Lounge, 2228 Haverford Road, Ardmore, PA for shots fired. The Delaware County 911 dispatcher reported to the responding officers that a 911 caller heard a female screaming in the front parking lot of Wynnewood Lanes. Upon arrival, officers located a 24 year old female victim with a superficial wound to the chest, who refused medical treatment at the scene. She was transported to the Haverford Township Police Department where she provide a statement in which she described an argument with her child's father. During the argument he produced a handgun and fired several shots at the victim, injuring her. The child of the victim was not on location during the shooting incident. The suspect left the scene prior to police arrival.
